Already since 2012 time by time international organizations ask PROVIDUS researchers to share their knowledge that our experts have gathered in Latvia and other countries and they create suggestions, that may help different reforms both political and administrative in developing countries.

We have provided consultations to different countries, usually in the Balkans, Caucasus and Central Asian regions as well as the Ukraine and Moldova.

Until now, PROVIDUS has helped the most with anti-corruption politics. For example, assigned by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), PROVIDUS researcher Valts Kalniņš performed regional research on corruption prevention measures in the OECD corruption prevention network Eastern European and Central Asian countries. The research has been compiled as a manual for officials, whose duties include corruption prevention. Commissioned by the European Council, PROVIDUS helped evaluate the systems for declaring income and financial position of officials in Armenia and the Ukraine.

In 2018 and 2019, the European Union anti-corruption initiative entrusted Valts Kalniņš with helping the Ukraine evaluate its corruption risk management system, regulation of conflict of interest as well as the electronic system of official's declarations. Governments of the Ukraine and other countries as well as civic society organizations use the work of this researcher to improve their administration.
